## Our efforts in Singapore are aligned with our global sustainability strategy

As a company committed to environmental stewardship and compliance, we recognize that our strategy and efforts must continue to evolve in the face of a changing climate. In February 2023, MSD Manufacturing Division in Singapore implemented a solar energy system on its site.

This initiative is part of the company's sustainability roadmap, wherein a solar photovoltaic system comprising of 8000+ solar modules with a total power generation of more than 4500 Mwh per year has been installed across the site. To put it in perspective, the total electricity generated each year is enough to power more than 1,200 HDB 4-room households in Singapore (\*Based on references made by Singapore Power Group)

#### Local initiatives





#### **Access to Health**

- We put patients at the center of everything we do. In the first 10 months of 2024, we are on track to exceed our goal of reaching over 400,000 people with our medicines and vaccines, through commercial channels, outreach, education, partnerships, advocacy and other ongoing efforts.
- Since 1 March 2024, we have partnered with the Singapore govt. to add 3 new immunotherapy indications to the Singapore Cancer Drug List, bringing the total subsidized indications to 25 and expanding affordable access for up to 90% of Singaporeans & permanent residents.
- To build health equity and literacy in the underserved groups for vaccination, we have
  collaborated with SATA CommHealth to launch their first ever HPV vaccination program for
  1,000 women from lower income households. We also partnered with Breast Cancer
  Foundation for Bosom Buddy project, an awareness roadshow reaching over 2,000 people.
- To elevate HPV awareness, our various campaigns have achieved a media reach of 4.3M people and 17,000 engaged visits to unbranded HPV sites.





#### **Employees**

Our commitment to giving back to the community has been exemplified through our Employee Business Resource Groups (or EBRGs) led partnerships with the external community organizations. We have 4 EBRGs with local chapters in Singapore and more than 600 employees are members of one or more of these EBRGs:

- **Women's Network** aims to empower and support women to realize their full professional potential and achieve gender equality through all levels of our organization.
- Asia Pacific Association focuses to develop future leaders, build social community and be a
  valued business partner by effectively promoting and leveraging Asian diversity.
- Next Gen Network connects the dots across all generations by building a community where
  every voice is represented, accelerating business outcomes and developing future leaders.
- CapABILITY network mission is to create a disability-confident workplace and ensure a
  disability-inclusive workplace for all.





#### **Environmental sustainability**

Globally in 2024 MSD committed to be net-zero across Scopes 1, 2 and 3 greenhouse gas emissions by 2045. In Singapore, we are aligned with our global targets for carbon, waste and water reduction :

- Waste management: "DIGGY" food digester installed across various sites where natural enzymes are used to break down our food leftovers and we have also enhanced our steam stripper system for reducing hazardous waste.
- Sustainable Lab practices: Visitors are now provided with fabric lab coats instead of
  disposables, resulting in 85% usage reduction of one-time use coats; while enhanced recycling
  practices for plastics and cardboard boxes resulted in recycling of 800kg of plastic and 250kg
  of cardboard boxes in our research labs.
- 'Green choice' lab products: For 2024, we partnered with our lab supplies aggregator to supply and adopt environmentally sustainable products that incorporate green chemistry and engineering.





#### **Ethics and Values**

- All employees are required to complete an annual Code of Conduct training including additional modules for people managers.
- Availability of our MSDethics.com reporting tool, which allows employees and third parties to raise concerns confidentially and anonymously, where each complaint is treated objectively with zero tolerance to retaliation.

In line with our commitment to our people and to build A Healthier MSD in a Healthier Singapore, we have launched the Enhanced Vaccination program in 2024.

This program aims to enable easy and convenient access to routine vaccinations to all employees and their dependents who have a prescription.

MSD employees in Singapore have already contributed more than **4,000 volunteering hours** in the underserved local communities. Each MSD employee gets 40 hours of paid volunteering leave annually.

MSD is partnering with the Centre for Healthcare Innovation (CHI) to embark on initiatives to drive thought leadership and foster shared learning in the areas of Preventive Health Care Development, Cancer Prevention and Survivorship, and Young Leaders Network Development.



Talent Accelerator Program - first for MRL-TMRC

MSD Research Lab's Translational Medicine Research Centre (MRL-TMRC) has launched the **TMRC Talent Accelerator**, a five-year talent development initiative in partnership with EDB, that seeks to train up to 30 scientists through our global MRL network.
